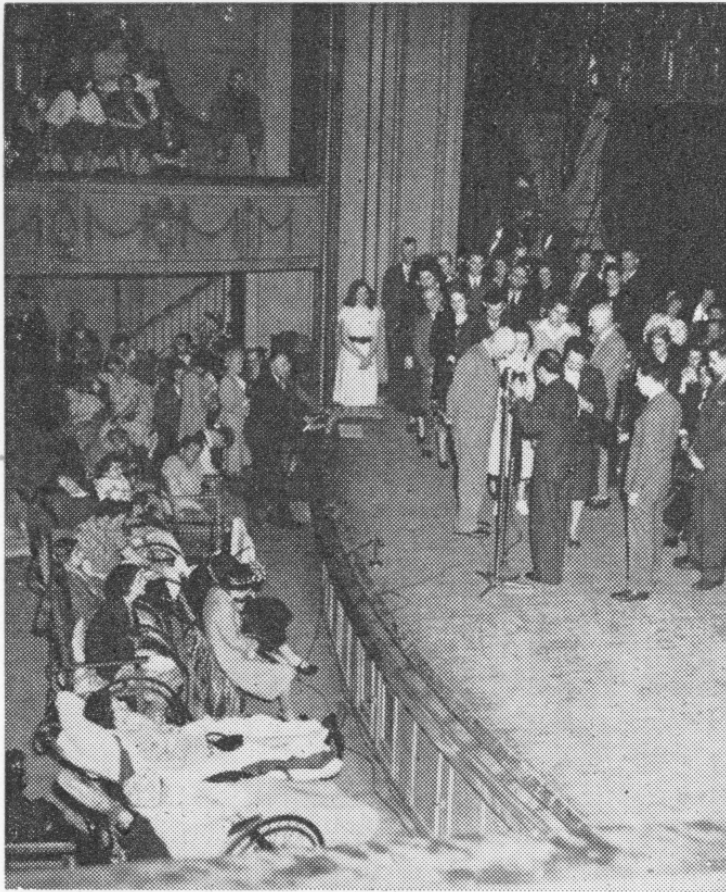


Branham Campaigns – Prayer for the sick

The photo below shows a large crowd of people that Brother Branham was preaching to and praying for. Notice the sick bay in front.



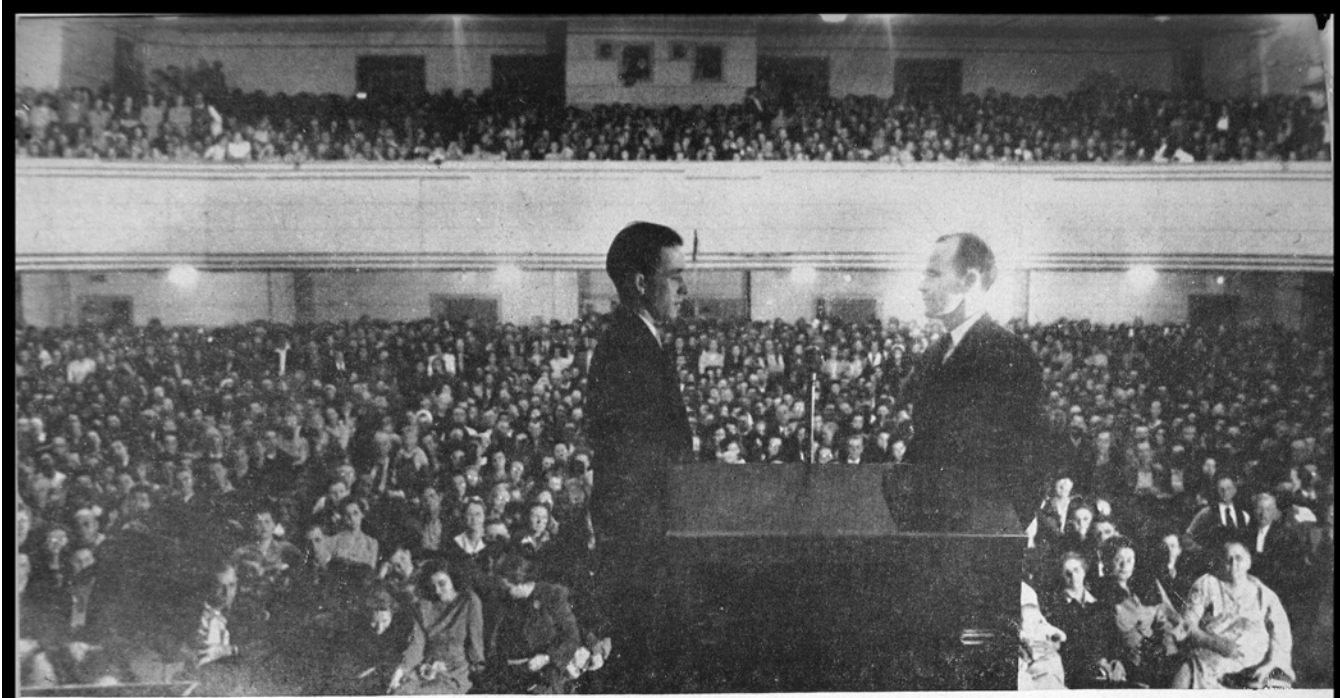
The great Tacoma ice arena seating 6,000 people filled the third night of Rev. Wm. Branham's appearance in the city.

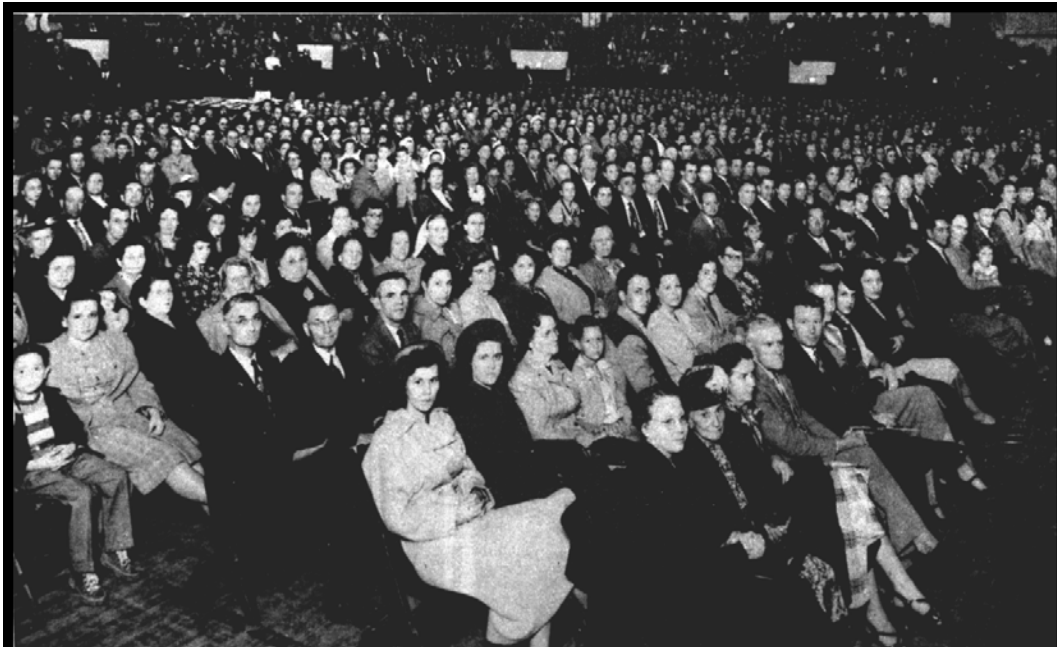
Brother Branham ministering to the Spanish brothers and sisters



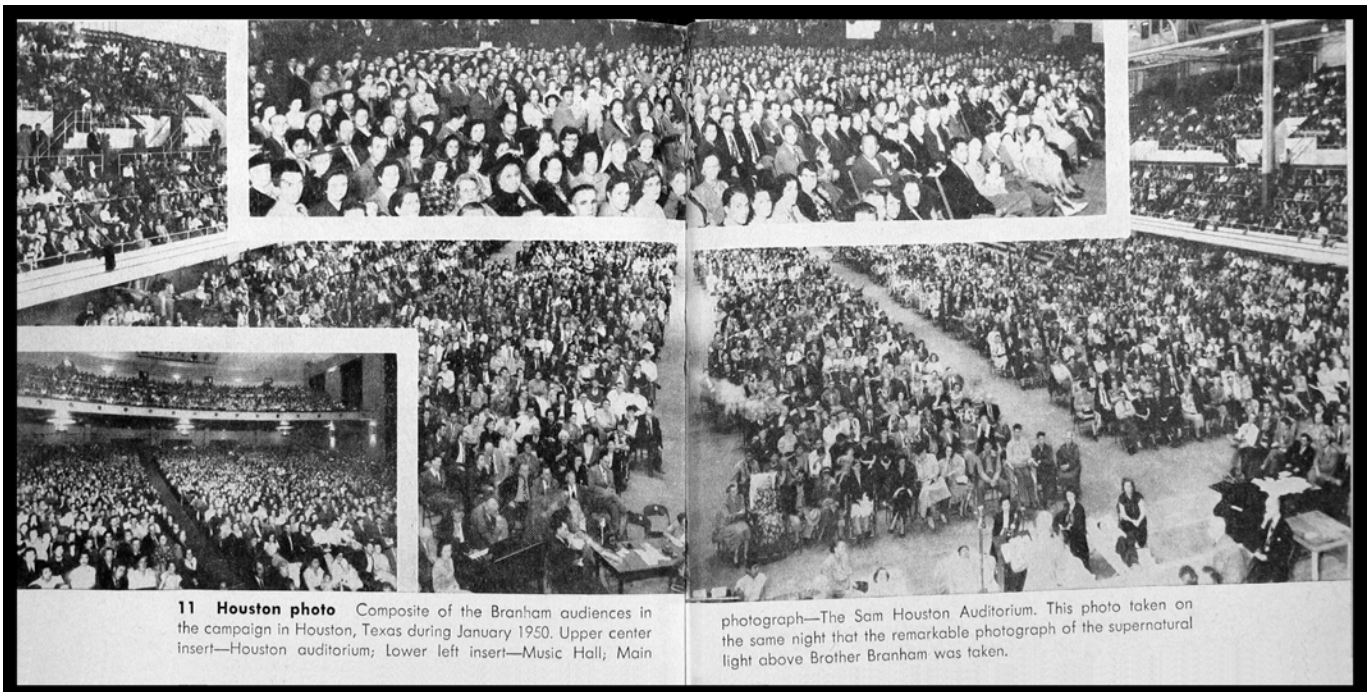
Brother Jose Ramirez was Brother Branham's first Spanish interpreter. He is the one facing the woman with the shawl in the picture on the left.

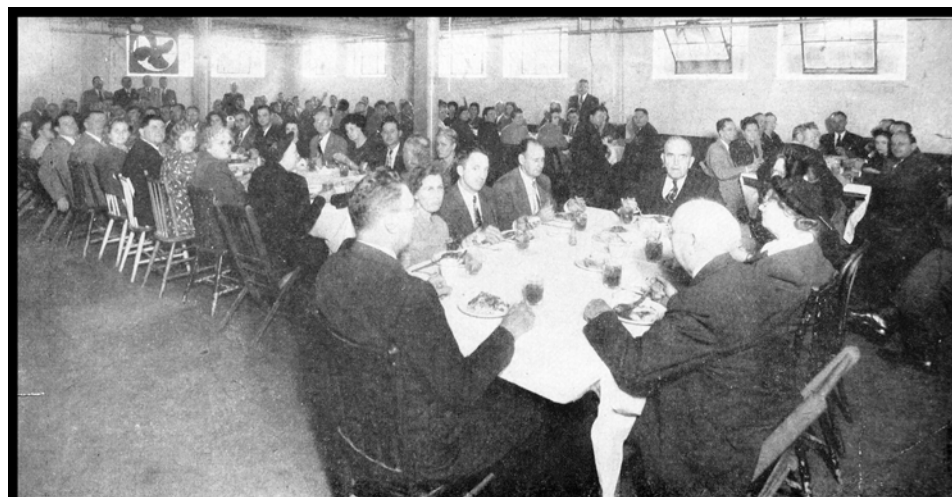

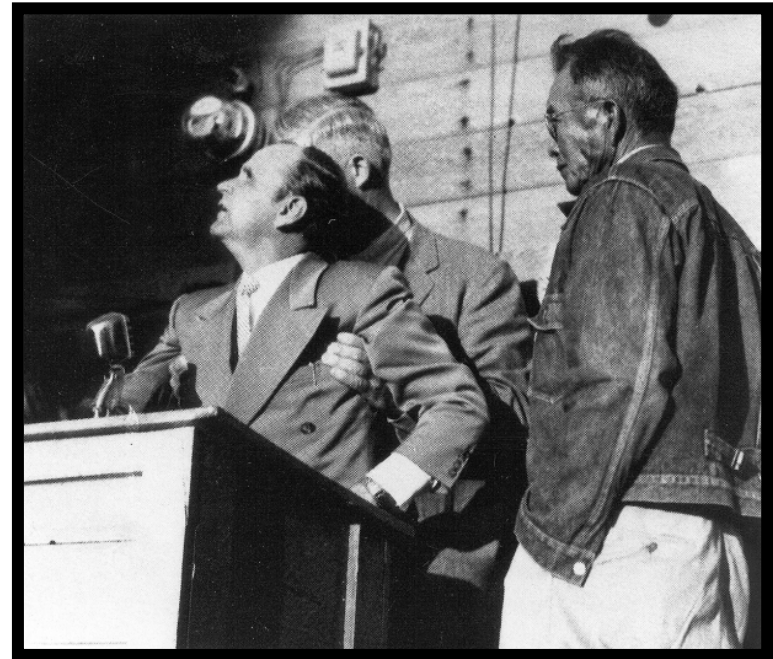
