5 Guidelines for Prayer:

- 1. Be spontaneous
- 2. Be specific
- 3. Pray the scriptures
- 4. Pray wholeheartedly
- 5. Pray continually

Praying the Scriptures

Reading the Bible daily will do some awesome things to your walk with God. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 say, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." When you become serious about learning the Word of God and obeying what it teaches, it will make an impact on you. When you learn to pray the scripture the Word will begin to come alive to you. Your prayers will gain new power because you will be praying God's Word which is eternal (Psalm 119:89).

Let's learn how to pray Scripture. Begin by selecting a a passage from the Bible that speaks to your heart on the subject you want to pray about. To pray the passage, just personalize it as you read it, applying what it says to yourself or to the person you are praying for. Respond to the passage mentally, emotionally and spiritually, and feel free to stop reading and continue praying as God's Spirit prompts you. You will find it changes your life. Let's work an example straight from Phillippians chapter 4.

"Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice. Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

Now here is the Scripture in the form of a prayer:

Heavenly Father, I rejoice in you always. I will say it again: I rejoice! You are an awesome, incredible God. I pray that my moderation, the change You have made in my life through the power of Your Holy Spirit would be evident to everybody around me. Lord I know that you are near. You have promised never to leave me, forsake me or abandon me. And for that reason, I will not be anxious about anything. You are on the throne, and I will trust in You. In everything, Lord, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving and praise, I will present my requests to You. And Lord, I ask that Your peace, which transcends all understanding, will guard my heart and mind in Christ Jesus from the cares and anxieties of this day. It is in the mighty name of Your Son, Jesus Christ that I pray. Amen!

Once you learn to pray Scripture and have made it a regular part of your devotion time, it will become difficult not to pray Scripture any time you read the Bible. You will find as a verse makes an impression on you that you you will stop reading and begin praying the passage and applying it to yourself and others.

Prayer Promises

Start your prayer time by reading these scriptures called the **Prayer Promises**. These are Scriptures that promise you that He does hear your prayers and will answer them. Reading these also builds your confidence and your faith to believe.

Praying for Pastors

Praying For Your Pastor is very important.

They are serving God and are under constant attack by the enemy.

They must be covered in prayer on a daily basis.

This prayer can be personalized by saying his name instead of the word pastor.

If you have a *reverend* or *father* as they do in the Catholic Church, then you can use those words instead of *pastor*. Or you can prayer for all pastors.
